## **DETAILED FAM TRIP ITINERARY**

---

### **DAY 1: TUESDAY, WELCOME TO CAIRO (Jan 26th)**

Arrival in Cairo. Meet and greet by your guide, who will escort you in a luxury air-conditioned vehicle to your chosen hotel. En route, you will be given all the practical information about your tour.

This evening, enjoy an excursion to the Sound & Light Show in the Pyramids area.

Return to the hotel for overnight.

### **DAY 2: WEDNESDAY, AMAZING PYRAMIDS OF CAIRO**

#### **Pyramids, Sphinx & GEM**

Breakfast at your hotel, and then we will start with a visit to one of the only remaining Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, the amazing Pyramids of Giza. Here, your guide will reveal the mysteries of these monuments and tell you about the secrets behind the inscrutable Sphinx.

In the afternoon, visit the Grand Egyptian Museum, located in front of the Pyramids Plateau.

Return to the hotel for overnight.

### **DAY 3: THURSDAY, EGYPTIAN MUSEUM OF ANTIQUITIES & DINNER CRUISE**

#### **Breakfast at the hotel.**

Visit the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, an amazing collection of artifacts that covers over 5,000 years of history and shows the incredible artistic talents of the ancient Egyptians.

Afternoon at leisure.

In the evening, pick up for a dinner cruise along the Nile. We will sail on a Pharaoh's cruise ship and have dinner while drifting past the amazing Cairo skyline. After dinner, we will see a show featuring traditional Tanoura spinning dances before our transfer back to the hotel.

Overnight in Cairo.

### **DAY 4: FRIDAY, CAIRO – ASWAN, CAPITAL OF NUBIA**

#### **High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk, Felucca Ride**

Breakfast at your hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Aswan.

Upon arrival, meet your guide. On the way to your cruise boat, you will visit the High Dam and the Unfinished Obelisk in the granite quarries, where you will discover the ingenious method used by the ancient Egyptians to cut stone for the obelisks.

Check in to the cruise boat and enjoy lunch on board.

In the afternoon, you will take a gentle sail around the Nile Cataracts on a felucca and see Elephantine Island and the Mausoleum of Aga Khan.

Do not miss the visit to the Nubian Village.

Dinner on board.

---

#### **DAY 5: SATURDAY, ASWAN – KOM OMBO**

##### **Abu Simbel & Kom Ombo Temple**

Breakfast on board. This morning, you will have a tour to Abu Simbel, with a 3:00 AM start, to see the amazing temples dedicated to Ramses III and his wife Nefertari. Carved from the rocks in the desert, these temples are an amazing testament to the engineering capabilities of the ancient Egyptians.

Lunch on the boat.

In the afternoon, arrive in Kom Ombo and visit these unique twin temples dedicated to Sobek, the Crocodile God, and Horus, the God of Light. Both gods were considered to be so strong that they needed separate temples.

Bargain for a souvenir in the bazaar on the way back, as tonight we will celebrate the Djellaba Party on board.

Dinner and overnight.

---

#### **DAY 6: SUNDAY, EDFU – LUXOR**

##### **Edfu and Luxor Temples**

Breakfast on board. After a quick transfer, we arrive at Edfu Temple, dedicated to the avenging sky god Horus. It is considered to be the best-preserved temple in all of Egypt and the site of the battle between the warring gods Horus and Seth.

Lunch on board as we continue to sail down the Nile toward the lock at Esna.

Take advantage of the lazy afternoon on board to watch the Nile float by. Known as the Father of Rivers, the waters from the river give life to over 80% of the Egyptian population.

Late afternoon arrival in Luxor and visit the Temple of Luxor, where Alexander the Great was crowned king of Egypt.

Dinner on board.

---

#### **DAY 7: MONDAY, LUXOR AMAZING THEBES**

Check out from the Cruise, Enjoy the Breakfast on a Felucca for One hour , then visit Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut's Temple, Colossi of Memnon, Karnak Temple, travel to HURGHADA.

Breakfast on the Felucca, then travelling to the Valley of the Kings here we will visit three of the amazing, decorated tombs before continuing through the valley we will visit the Temple of Egypt's only female pharaoh

Queen Hatshepsut. Then, enjoy a photo stop at the Colossi of Memnon. Finally a visit of the stunning complex of Karnak Temple, Egypt's largest religious complex. In the afternoon we will transfer you by road to the famous resort on the Red Sea Hurghada. Known for its white sandy beaches, amazing turquoise sea it is home to an amazing variety of marine flora and fauna which attracts divers from all over the world.

Arrival and overnight.

---

#### **DAYS 8 & 9: TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY, HURGHADA**

##### **Red Sea**

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy free days to relax by the crystal-clear waters of the Red Sea, recover from your flight, and start to experience Egyptian hospitality.

Make the most of your days at the all-inclusive resort: sunbathe by the pool, take part in optional activities like taking the submarine tour to see the amazing coral reefs, watch the sea turtles, and marvel at the amazing sea life. The submarine, featuring personal round viewing windows, offers an unparalleled glimpse into the underwater paradise of the Red Sea. Or just kick back and relax at one of the many bars.

#### **DAY 10: THURSDAY, HURGHADA – CAIRO**

##### **Cairo**

Breakfast at the hotel. At the designated time, transfer to the airport for your flight back to Cairo.

Arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Possibility to enjoy an optional excursion to visit Old Cairo, the medieval heart of the city, with its walled Citadel, Alabaster Mosque, and of course its most famous bazaar, Khan El Khalili.

Overnight in Cairo.
